Remember that the final enrollment of 2019-20 honors and AP classes will be subject to department and administrative approval and will be based upon classroom performance during the current school year.

All courses are year-long (two semesters in length) unless otherwise indicated on the back of this worksheet. One semester courses will be indicated with a (\*). Courses that are either one or two semesters long are indicated with a (\*\*).

General Graduation Requirements for the Class of 2020 are as follows (NOTE: there are specific courses required within many of the departments -- i.e, US Government as one of the Social Studies required courses):

- 1 year of Fine Arts
- 1 year of Physical Education
- 1 semester of Health

- Credit in Foundations in Ethics and Technology

### DEPARTMENTS WITH REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADE 12:

At DeLaSalle, students in grade 12 are required to earn at least two semester credits each year in **Theology, English, and Social Studies**. Students may take additional courses in each department as elective choices. Please indicate the student's choices in each department for each of two semesters:

### OTHER DEPARTMENTS:

In **Mathematics** and **Science**, students in grades 9-10-11 are required to earn at least two semester credits each year and are invited to continue mathematics and science study in grade 12 as elective choices.

In **Modern Languages**, students are required to earn 4 semesters of a single language.

In **Fine Arts**, graduation requirements include a minimum of two semester credits.

In **Physical Education**, graduation requirements include a minimum of two semester credits, as well as one semester credit in **Health**.

Students may also register for one **Study Hall** each semester.
